<p>1.Total graduation credits: 128</p> <p>2.Required general education credit/ hour: 28/ 28; college required credit/ hour : 17/17</p> <p>3.Required professional credit/ hour : 30/30 : elective credit/hour : 53/53</p> <p>4.Single-semester courses can be flexibly divided or adjusted between semesters according to actual situation.</p> <p>5.The General Education Center of our school has formulated the "Implementation Rules for the Comprehensive Chinese Language Proficiency Test for Students of Jingwen University of Science and Technology". Students must pass the Chinese Language Proficiency Test before graduation.</p> <p>6.The PE Office of our school has issued the "Implementation Rules for Physical Fitness Graduation Requirements for Students of Jingwen University of Science and Technology". Students must pass the physical fitness test before graduation.</p> <p>7. Students are free to take courses in the four areas of General Education Courses, but it is not allowed to take the same type of courses twice. Graduation requires 4 credits.</p> <p>8. For a more flexible course-taking, 20 credits (the maximum) can be taken from other departments (including 2 Micro-credits and general education credits). However, Japanese language-related courses offered by external departments will not be recognized by our department.</p> <p>9. Courses can be classified as Terminal Learning (suggested for juniors or seniors) : Project Study, Advanced Business Japanese Conversation (I) , Advanced Business Japanese Conversation (II) .</p> <p>10. This group's English proficiency test must meet the CEF A2 standard listed in the "Ministry of Education-subsidized Private Technical School Development Fund Allocation and Application Key Points" and obtain a certificate, or obtain other international certificates equivalent to CEF A2 level, or a campus English proficiency test score of 350 points.</p> <p>11. Courses can be classified as Functional Competency: Sightseeing Guide Japanese</p> <p>12. Obtaining credits for professional required / elective corporate internships, please refer to the relevant regulations of the Group on internships.</p> <p>13. The compulsory courses set by the college: "Language and Culture" and "Integrated Application of Image and Language" will start in the first semester, and "Contemporary Art" will start in the second semester. Each course will have 6 weeks of operation planning and performance.</p> <p>14. Must meet the following conditions to graduate:</p> <p>(1) Obtain Japanese Language Proficiency Test Level 2 (N2) or above after enrolling in school , students only allowed to use the "Japanese language proficiency development" to pass the graduation requirement after failing the N2 Japanese language test at least once.</p> <p>(2) Professional certificate: Student must obtain one of the following certificates before graduation: A. Business Japanese Proficiency Test (BJT) 400 points or above . B. Test of Practical Japanese (J-TEST) Level C . Japanese Secretary Test level 3. D. Japanese business document verification level 3. E. Professional and Technical Examination - Chinese Tour Guide. F .Professional and Technical Professional Examination - Chinese Tour Escort. G. Professional and Technical Professionals Examination - Foreign Tour Guide (Japanese) . H. Professional and technical examinations - Foreign Tour Escort (Japanese) . I. Japanese Licenced guide. J. International Business Reception Etiquette(Certificate No.8550). K.International Business Social Etiquette(Certificate No.8551). L. MOCC Office Master's Certification . M.
