Fu Jen Studies: Literature and Linguistics is a publication of the College of Foreign Languages at Fu Jen Catholic University. The journal seeks articles pertaining to any aspect of literature or linguistics. It also maintains a tradition of featuring articles that take a comparative approach to, or study influences between, Western and Asian cultural expressions. Fu Jen Studies publishes a regular annual issue (once a year, in July), as well as occasional special topics issues. The journal is indexed in the MLA International Bibliography and in Linguistics and Language Behavior Abstracts (LLBA).

1. The Journal shall not be held liable for copyright violations. In cases of violations, the author, not the Journal, shall bear full responsibility for all legal consequences. In addition, this Journal will not accept any future submissions made by the author.
2. Format: For all questions of form follow the most recent edition of the MLA Handbook (for articles on literature) or of the LSA Style Sheet (for articles on linguistics). Manuscripts should have a list of Works Cited (MLA Handbook) or References (LSA Style Sheet). Notes, if necessary, should be Endnotes.
3. Transcription of Chinese Characters: Pinyin system of Romanization.
4. Language: Articles for Fu Jen Studies may be written in English, French, German, Italian, Japanese, or Spanish.
5. Length: Ideally, essays should be 15-30 typed pages.
6. Abstract and Keywords: Submissions should include a 300-500 words abstract and a list of keywords.
7. Author Information: In a brief cover letter, please provide your name, academic affiliation and position (if applicable), email address, and mailing address. Include your name on the first page of the article, but not on subsequent pages.
8. When submitting a manuscript, please send three hard copies along with other documents to the following address:

9. Evaluation: Submissions are peer-reviewed in an anonymous two-stage process. In the event that the external reviewers disagree, the piece will be sent to the third external reviewer. The editorial board and the length of time needed to complete the review process will determine whether the submission is chosen for publication and, if so, which volume it

will appear in.

10. Production: When revisions have been completed, contributors should submit their final draft to the editor in Word format. Authors of accepted articles must agree to publication by this journal and electronic formats. Published articles may not be reprinted, translated, or excerpted without express written consent of this journal.
11. Offprints: Authors of accepted articles will receive 1 copy ,2 discs of the journal issue and 5 offprints. Fu Jen Studies is made available to libraries and research institutions in Taiwan and abroad on an exchange basis. There is no cash income and no royalties can be paid.
